



Safe System of Work Working in Adverse Weather

1. Always plan for working in adverse weather conditions.
2. Ensure that all personal protective equipment provided and for use in external adverse weather conditions is carried on the vehicle and available.
3. Allow extra time when driving in difficult weather conditions, particularly in ice and snow, both on the road and on-site.
4. Remember when working on the client site(s) in such conditions to be visually seen by third party and other drivers.
5. Take extra care when climbing into and alighting from vehicles
6. Carry out work that can be completed safely in such conditions.
7. Do not undertake repair work on a trailer that would be considered unsafe in adverse wind, rain, icy and snowy conditions.
8. Ensure hot drinks and suitable foods are available and take planned breaks from the adverse conditions in the welfare facilities, in agreement with the management team and the client.
9. Only use equipment and vehicles such as scissor lifts and forklifts, if it is essential and safe to do so.
